Can I get tickets at the gate?

We will be welcoming walk-ins on the day and monitoring capacity.

What should I bring?

Performances will be on the outdoor stage. We suggest bringing picnic rugs and beach/camping chairs for your comfort. The lawn will have designated 'picnic rug only' areas, and there will be space for chairs behind those areas.

Here's a checklist of what to bring:

- Picnic rug, beach/camping chair
- Warm jumper and a raincoat in case of wet weather (indoor spaces will be open).
- You may wish to bring your own food.

Can I fill up my water bottle at the event?

Yes, so don't forget to bring your water bottles! We'll have a Water Van with refreshing chilled water for free at the event.

Will there be alcohol at this event?

This is an alcohol-free event however a range of non-alcoholic drinks will be available for purchase.

Will there be an ATM available?

No - but most market and food stalls will have eftpos available.

What happens if it rains?

The show will go on, so bring ponchos and wet weather gear as a precaution. There is indoor space in the Kingston Butter Factory building where you can shelter from the rain.

WORLD OF CULTURES Pre-event information (FAQs)

How do I get there and where do I park?

By car: Limited parking is available onsite so you will need to arrive early to secure a space. Alternatively, there is additional parking located at Logan Entertainment Centre (LEC) 170 Wembley Road, Logan Central.

By train: KBF is located next to Kingston Train Station and is accessible via Beenleigh or Ferny Grove lines. Disembark at Kingston Station then take a 200m stroll from the station to KBF. The train station and the entire KBF Precinct are accessible for prams and mobility devices.

Is the venue accessible to people with disability?

KBF is committed to providing an inclusive experience for all attendees. Here's what you can expect:

- The entire precinct is accessible for prams and mobility devices, and we'll have a platform for accessible viewing over the lawn.
- If you or your guests have audio sensitivities, we recommend bringing over-ear headphones
- Accessible bathrooms, including 'Changing Places' facility, are available onsite in the Kingston Butter Factory building.
- A relaxed area will be available for patrons to access at any time during the event.
